Superkolong Diamond Operations – South Africa



Superkolong prepared a special yellow parcel for sale in Antwerp in May 2016. The parcel included a special 112 carat yellow diamond which sold for \$2.25m.

One-year production through 31 March 2016

Superkolong achieved the following ore processing and carat recovery numbers for the financial year.

Highlights for 2016 financial year ended March 2016:

- Sale of Kimberley purple \$5.6m
- Sale of special 128 carat fancy yellow \$2.3m
- Average price of \$108 per carat was achieved for the year (excluding specials)
- 2.5m tons processed with 109 233 carats recovered
- 103k carats sold during the year
- Total revenue of €16.7m for the fiscal year
- Installation of new DMS recovery plant

Alluvial Ventures achieved the following ore processing and carat recovery numbers for the financial year.

Highlights for 2016 financial year ended March 2016:

- Completed the upgrade of the primary crushing circuit which improved production capacity
- Installation of a new tertiary crushing unit was delayed due to poor weather conditions, but has been commissioned in Q1 of the new financial year (2017)
- · Operating costs remained within budget
- Ten successful tenders were held during the period
- New staff accommodations were purchased and placed on site. Occupation is scheduled for Q2 FY 2017.

DIAMONDS, continued

Kolo Mine - Lesotho

- After significant delays related to community issues and a further requirement to complete an addendum to the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA), the Kolo project is close to production
- Crushing of hard A type kimberlite began in May 2016
- The establishment of the processing plant has been completed and commissioned, with only the final recovery plant requiring commissioning, which is due by end August 2016
- Further strategic land acquisitions were made to ensure suitable space availability for operations
- First production is expected to begin by September 2016
- Great effort has been made to foster good working relationships with the immediate community of Kolo Ha Petlane. We see early indications of these relationships being established on a good foundation.


